There were **698 major data breaches** in the US as of May 2017, representing more than **10 million** compromised records.

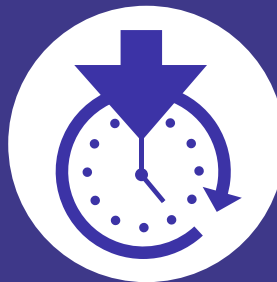
LOSS
